I was admitted to the Saskatchewan Bar in 2001. I also took seminars in Alternate Dispute Resolution. I now have a small solo practice, Mitten Law, in Redvers, SK. Prior to entering a career in Law, I taught 31 years in Redvers, SK, including teaching the following subjects, Chemistry 20 and 30, Physics 20 and 30, General Science 10, and Psychology 20 and 30, and other subjects as assigned.
