Menu suggestions for a family Valentine's Day brunch

Create your own treats for your partner — and the kids!

Buying delicious treats for Valentine's Day is sweet, but making your own homemade goodies is even better! This year, surprise your loved ones—children included—with homemade treats that are easy to make and sure to impress.

HOMEMADE JUJUBES

It may seem surprising, but making jujubes at home is simpler than you might think. Pour half a cup of fruit juice or puree into a small saucepan. Whisk in about 20 grams of powdered gelatin and let it sit for a few minutes.

Heat the mixture over medium heat until it becomes liquid. Then, add two tablespoons of sugar and a few drops of lemon juice. Bring the mixture to a boil once more and then quickly pour it into moulds with fun shapes like hearts or roses. Refrigerate the moulds until the jujubes have set. Once they're ready, pop them out and enjoy!



A YOGURT DELIGHT

In a large bowl, combine two cups of plain yogurt, three tablespoons of maple syrup and two tablespoons of lemon juice. Spread the mixture on a parchment-lined baking sheet. Sprinkle berries over top and place in the freezer for a few hours. Once firm, cut into pieces. That's it. You now have a guilt-free frozen treat!
