## Southeast Saskatchewan and Southwest Manitoba Summer Event Roundup

There are lots of events coming up across the area this summer, from Canada Day celebrations to rodeos, to fairs, to ball tournaments and much more. ### **June 28-30 Bobby Vargo Tournament, Kipling**

June 28-30 will be the 12th annual Bobby Vargo Memorial Slow-Pitch Tournament in Kipling. Ball games start on Friday. On Saturday there will be a pancake breakfast, kids activities, and the Nutrien Home Run Derby and Calcutta at 6 pm. Sunday includes the Kipling Kid Care Calcutta with DJ Dumo from 10 pm to 2 am and a silent auction. The whole weekend wraps up on July 1 with fireworks hosted by the town of Kipling.

### **June 28-30 Carlyle Fun Dayz**

Carlyle is going all out this year with a midway, games and fair food by Canuck Amusements out of Selkirk, Manitoba. The fun goes down at the Carlyle Sports Arena

### **June 30-July 1 Oxbow Multiculturalism and Canada Day Weekend**

Oxbow is going all out on the Canada Day weekend with a free event that features fireworks, live music, a duck derby, food trucks, vendors, a petting zoo, bouncy castles, a parade and beer gardens.

### **July 1 Canada Day celebration, Elkhorn**

This is one of the biggest Canada Day celebrations in the area. This year it will feature a pancake breakfast, a parade, kids' activities at the museum, a threshing display, supper, and a spark show at dusk, followed by fireworks.

### **July 13 Bulls and Broncs, Moosomin**

The Bulls and Broncs event will be a full day of fun in Moosomin, starting with the Firemen's pancake breakfast. The Chamber of Commerce parade will take place at 10 am. The Bulls and Broncs, consisting of bull riding, saddle bronc, bareback riding, and novice rough stock, takes place at the Rodeo Grounds at 7 pm. Beer gardens will be open all night and there will also be a cabaret.

### **July 19-21 Moose Mountain Pro Rodeo, Kennedy**

The village of Kennedy is home to one of the only pro rodeos in the region, with many of the riders coming fresh from the Calgary Stampede.

This year there will be rodeo slack starting on the Friday, followed by a parade at 11 am Saturday morning. The action continues Saturday with a demolition derby at noon following the parade, followed by pro rodeo action at 5 pm. In the evening, music will be provided by DJ Dumo at 9 pm. On Sunday there will be a pancake breakfast at the Kennedy Friendship Centre followed by a Cowboy Church Service at 11 am at the rodeo grounds. At 2 pm the rodeo action starts.

The weekend also includes free camping at the rodeo grounds and food booths.

### **July 26-27 Maryfield Agricultural Society Fair**

This annual event in the village of Maryfield features an agricultural society fair and horse show. The fair day is Friday, July 26 with a pancake breakfast, tin can kitchen, exhibits, bouncers, a mini ferris wheel, kids' carnival games, music, supper and more! On July 26 there is a horse clinic, and on July 27 there is a horse show with clinician and judge Kim Leugner.

# New craft brewery in Moosomin

After a lot of planning and preparation Skout Brewing opened its doors to the public on April 12 in Moosomin.

Aaron Grandguillot and his wife Gena Shepherd moved to Moosomin from southern Ontario to start the brewery. Grandguillot said the idea for Skout Brewing was born during Covid.

"During Covid we were still living in Ontario and we came back home to visit family. After that visit, we realized how much we missed being home and decided to move back to Saskatchewan," he says. "From there it became an idea and we thought once we move home, we will also attempt to build a brewery and chase our dream."

He said the couple have always been interested in craft beer.

"My wife and I have always enjoyed going to craft breweries, and we've lived in a few different places like B.C. and Ontario and we always thought a craft brewery was a fun place to be and it became a dream of ours. When Gena's family ramped

up with the hops farm (JGL Shepherd Farms), we got to know the business a little better and eventually we de-

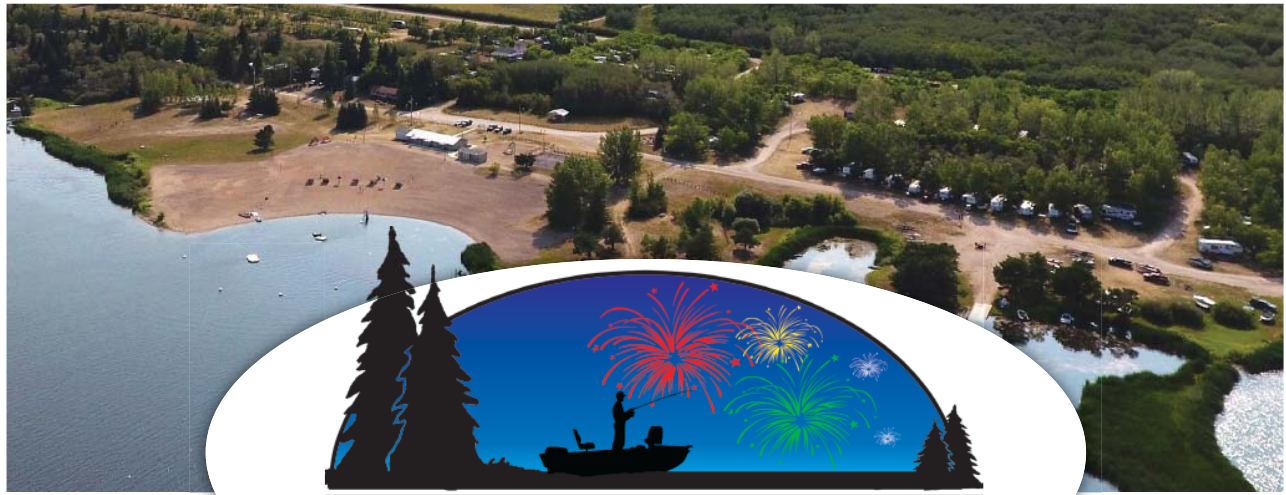
ecided to try and make a go of it ourselves."

## August 2-4 Elkhorn Western Weekend

Pony chuckwagon and chariot races are the centrepiece of Elkhorn's Western weekend August 2-4.

There is free admission to the event on Friday with chariots at 7 pm and chuckwagons at 8:30 pm that evening. On both Saturday and Sunday, chariots are at 1 pm and chuckwagons are at 3 pm. There will also be children's entertainment both days.

Other events that weekend include a cornhole tourney, a live calcutta auction following the races, as well as silent calcutta sold, a slo-pitch tournament all weekend, a Saturday night social at the rink, concession booths, and an open air movie on the sports grounds.

## August 3 Wawota Heritage Days

Saturday, August 3 will be Wawota's annual Heritage Day, featuring a pancake breakfast, a parade, kids gymkhana, face painting, a petting zoo and pony rides, and kids activities. There will also be beach volleyball and a soap box derby. The day wraps up with fireworks and a cabaret. All day entertainment will be provided by the band Ragged Edge.

## August 5-8 and August 12-15

### Kenosee Lake Kitchen Party Music Festival and Camp

Held at Moose Mountain Provincial Park, these four-day immersive, all-ages music festivals and camps allow people of all ages and abilities to learn to play music and make art.

A long list of Kitchen Fest performers are slated to perform from Monday to Wednesday each week. The camp will focus on fiddle, guitar, ukulele, banjo, voice, piano, cello and art. There will be camp counsellors and land-based activities, as well as songwriting, dancing, swimming, canoeing, and forest hikes.

There are also beer gardens both nights and a full canteen both days, with a DJ on the Saturday night.

## September 14-15 Carlyle Homespun

This year's Carlyle Homespun event features the 38th annual craft show and sale, and the 22nd annual quilt show. The craft show and sale runs 10 am to 7 pm Saturday and 10 am to 4 pm Sunday and is located at the Carlyle Sports arena. The quilt show runs 10 am to 4 pm Saturday and 10 am to 3 pm Sunday and is located at the Memorial Hall on Main Street in Carlyle. On Saturday, September 14 there will also be a pancake breakfast at the Legion Hall at 8 am and a draw for \$100 in Vendor Bucks from 5-6 pm that day.

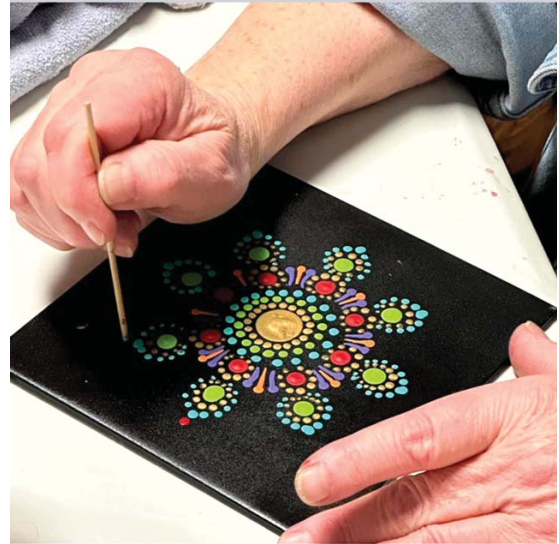

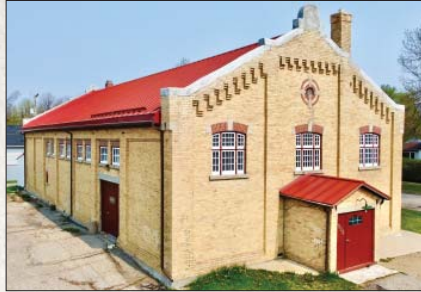

The town of Moosomin has a number of well preserved historic buildings and sites.



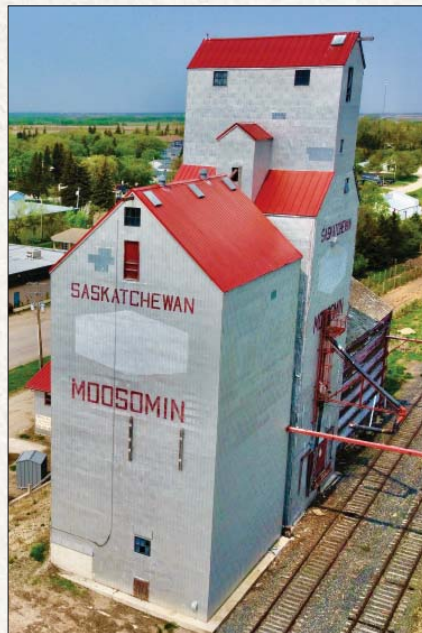
The Municipal office, also home to an engineering firm, was built as a Bank of Commerce branch in 1902.

The Original McNaughton Building built in 1882



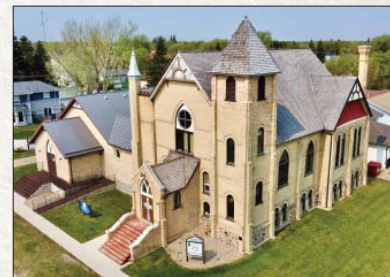

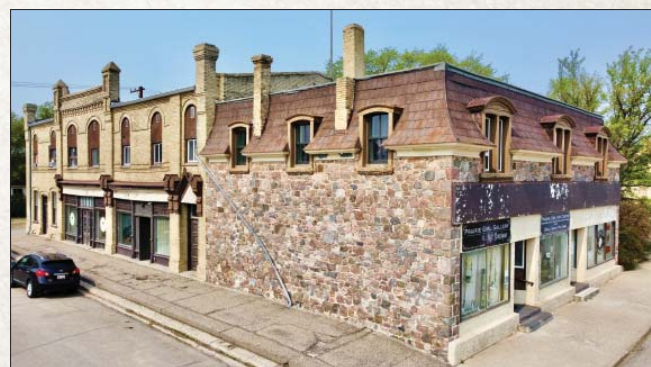

The village of Kennedy is home to one of the only pro rodeos in the region, with many of the riders coming fresh from the Calgary Stampede. This year there will be rodeo slack starting on the Friday, followed by a parade at 11 am Saturday morning. The action continues Saturday with a demolition derby at noon following the parade, followed by pro rodeo action at 5 pm. In the evening, music will be provided by DJ Dumo at 9 pm. On Sunday there will be a pancake breakfast at the Kennedy Friendship Centre followed by a Cowboy Church Service at 11 am at the rodeo grounds. At 2 pm the rodeo action starts.

Pony chuckwagon and chariot races are the centrepiece of Elkhorn's Western weekend August 2-4. There is free admission to the event on Friday with chariots at 7 pm and chuckwagons at 8:30 pm that evening. On both Saturday and Sunday, chariots are at 1 pm and chuckwagons are at 3 pm. There will also be children's entertainment both days.

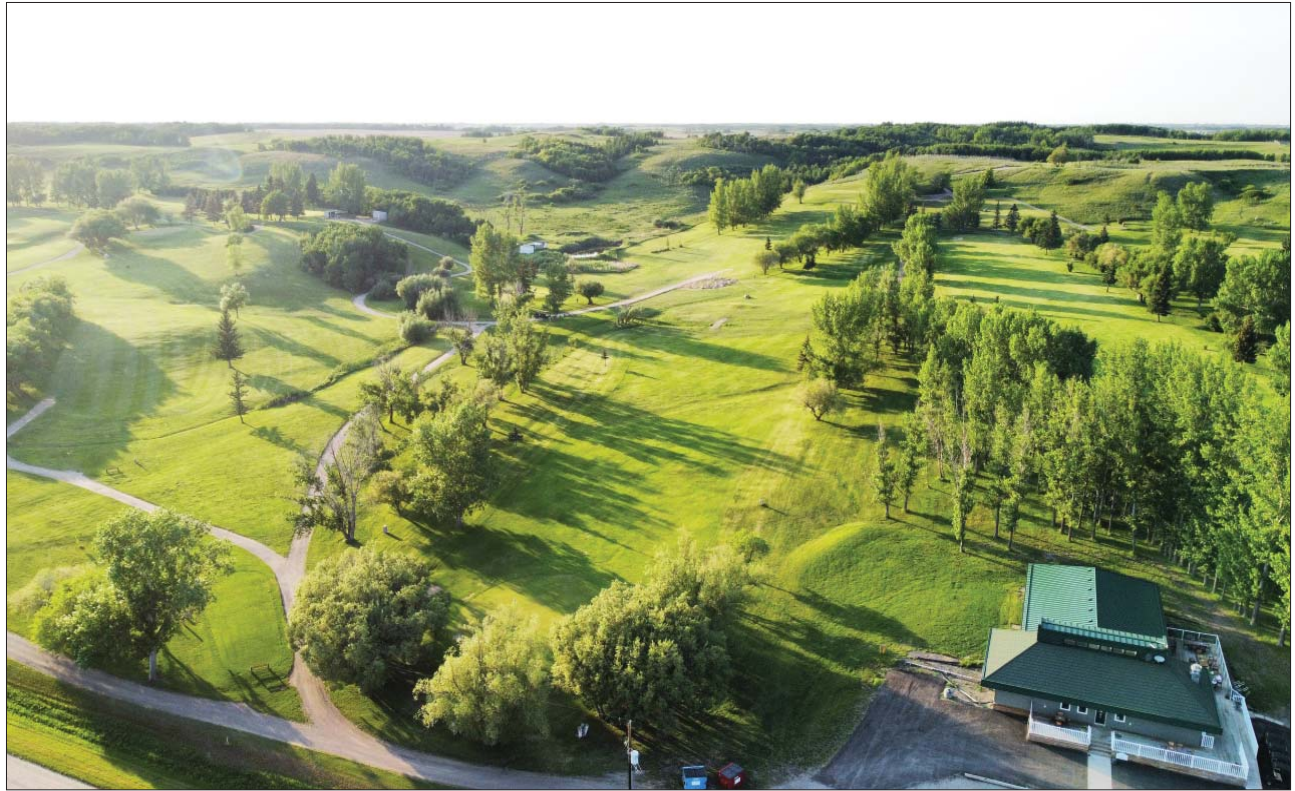
Other events that weekend include a cornhole tourney, a live calcutta auction following the races, as well as silent calcutta sold, a slo-pitch tournament all weekend, a Saturday night social at the rink, concession booths, and an open air movie on the sports grounds.

## Local beer and cider

Skout Brewing features their own brews as well as beer and cider from other Saskatchewan craft breweries.

"We have 12 taps, half of which are our own beer. We also serve some cider and some other craft brewery beer, it is all Saskatchewan made products.

"My goal is to bring styles of beer from around the world to Moosomin made with local ingredients. Of our first beer there will be a German style, American style, Belgian style, and many more varieties to come. We will have growlers available upon opening and we will offer cans as soon as the labels come in.

"We wanted to create a fun, vibrant place where people can come and have a beverage. Eventually we will have more seating outside but unfortunately we ran out of time with the weather to build the patio, so for now it will just be indoor seating."

## Local hops being used

All of the hops in Skout Brewing's beers are sourced locally from JGL Shepherd farms.

"The hops farm was the idea of my brother-in-law Justin, he was the original craft beer fan in our family and he turned me on to it as well," says Grandguillot.

"The family used to farm, now they mainly rent the land but Justin wanted the farm to continue producing and he was looking for new ways to do that, so they started with growing some hops, then they expanded out, and

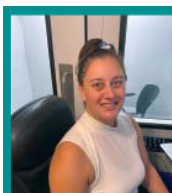

# Discover history at Moosomin's museum

The Moosomin Museum is a perfect space for any history buff to check out a few of the historic items of southeast Saskatchewan.

The museum is located just off Park Avenue in Moosomin—stop in for a trip to the past!

The museum features history from Moosomin and the surrounding area with two old churches, antique automobiles, and a shop with vintage artifacts to display.

The artifacts range from old farm equipment to furniture originally built in Moosomin, and various others.

In addition to the collection of quality vintage vehicles, there is also an array of old farming machinery—including tractors and combines.

A highlight of the museum's collection is the restored Fudge Snowplane.

Snowplanes were built to glide over the snow, powered by a rear propeller. Two of the major snow plane manufacturers in North America were at Moosomin and Spy Hill. The Fudge snow plane, started by Robert Fudge, was made in Moosomin in a factory at the corner of Main and Broadway. Lorch snow planes, named after Karl Lorch, were made in Spy Hill.

The snowplanes were a popular mode of winter transportation when it was more difficult to clear roads



in winter.

Inside the museum, you can check out many historical relics including photos, Second World War gear, classic books, hospital equipment, military items, and uniforms.

All items have been donated by members of the community.

The museum is open Wednesday to Sunday afternoons from 1-5 pm in July and August.

## Walk through history at Rocanville Museum

For those interested in prairie history, you won't be disappointed with a stop at the Rocanville and District Museum. This large agricultural museum boasts an extensive collection of gas and steam engines, a restored CPR station, a school building, general store, an old church, and antique farm machinery and tools.

The museum also sells the famous Symons Oilers as souvenirs. Based out of his machine shop in Rocanville, Ernie Symons sold his oilcan, the Symons Oiler, throughout North America and around the world. Starting with his first 24 oilcans in 1924, production reached its peak during the Second World War. In 1943, Symons delivered 65,000 of his oilers to the Department of Defense for use on military vehicles, including ships, planes, and submarines. With 32 workers on the job that summer, he usually had orders for 50,000 to 60,000 units to be filled.

Symons then spent \$500 securing patents in Canada, the United States, Great Britain, and France. Containers of different sizes with different features were added in later years. With its "wire fence" handle and trademark design, Symons developed an oilcan that is still considered the standard by many today.

On display at the museum are steam engines, thresh-

ing machines, stoves, washing machines, grain mills, chinaware, small personal items, household items, tools, switchboards, First Nations artifacts, military items, school desks, and many other items of former years.

There are all sorts of interesting displays at the Rocanville Museum, including a display from when the Kraft Celebration Tour came to Rocanville, and a display dedicated to the time that Rocanville Museum participated in the world record breaking Harvest for Hunger in Langenburg.

The old school at the museum has also been modified and turned into an active and historical kids' area with lots of fun stuff for kids to do.

This year, work is also underway on a new display about the history of the Métis people who live in the area.

Rocanville Museum also hosts a Museum Day every year to help with finances in September. The day starts with a pancake breakfast and ends with a barbecue beef supper. Demonstrations of pioneer life will be held throughout the day, and there will be entertainment and a threshing demonstration in the afternoon. This year Museum Day is on September 14.

The Rocanville Museum is open daily in July and August from 10 am to 5 pm.

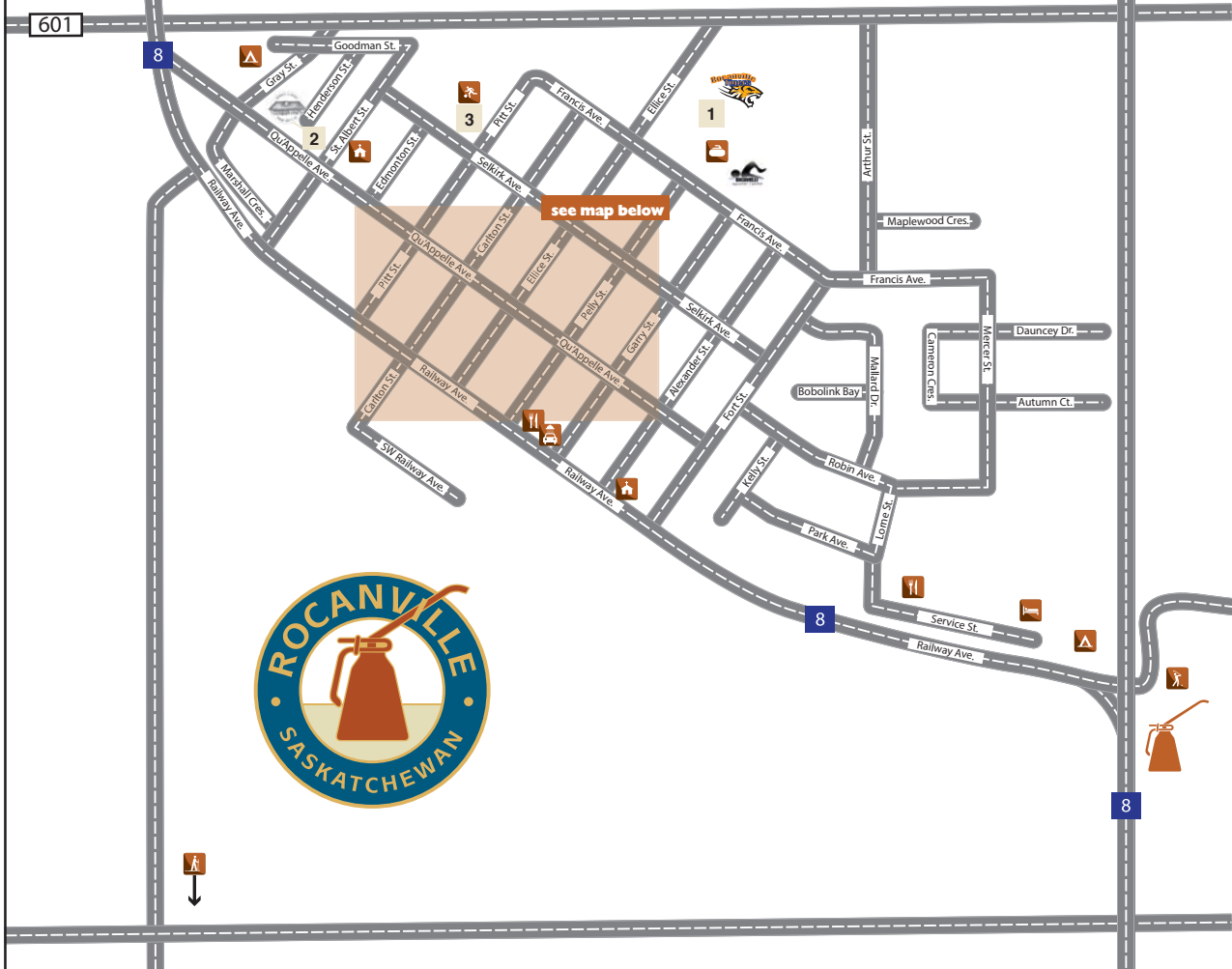
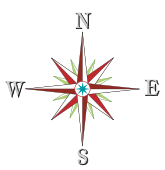

# Welwyn Regional Park: Beautiful lake, beautiful campground

Tucked in the shallow valley containing Beaver Creek, Welwyn Regional Park is a hidden treasure for people who love a quick and easy getaway to the outdoors.

The park is located two kilometres north of the village of Welwyn just off Highway #308.

It includes Welwyn Lake, a small and peaceful lake open to swimming, fishing, and boating, with a beautiful little sandy beach area. The lake is known for some great fishing, and there is a boat launch available for those looking to spend a day on the lake.

On the hillside overlooking the lake is a well-treed and well-cared-for campground with 40 campsites (some with electrical and picnic tables).

The lake was built with the damming of Beaver Creek in the mid-1960s. Welwyn Lake is fed by springs and run-off coming from the west. In the past, anglers have caught pike and perch there.

The park is well treed with poplar, oak, willow, and birch trees, while hazelnuts, saskatoon bushes, chokecherries, and cranberries have been found along the banks of the reservoir.

During one week over the summer, swimming lessons are provided at the park with a registered instructor, and people flock to the park that week to camp, swim and enjoy the laid back atmosphere of family fun in the park.

The week of lessons are always capped off with a barbecue in the park on the last day. This week swimming lessons will be held July 1-5.

Welwyn Regional Park is self-supporting and operated by a committed group of volunteers from the area, and the love and care they take with the park shows!

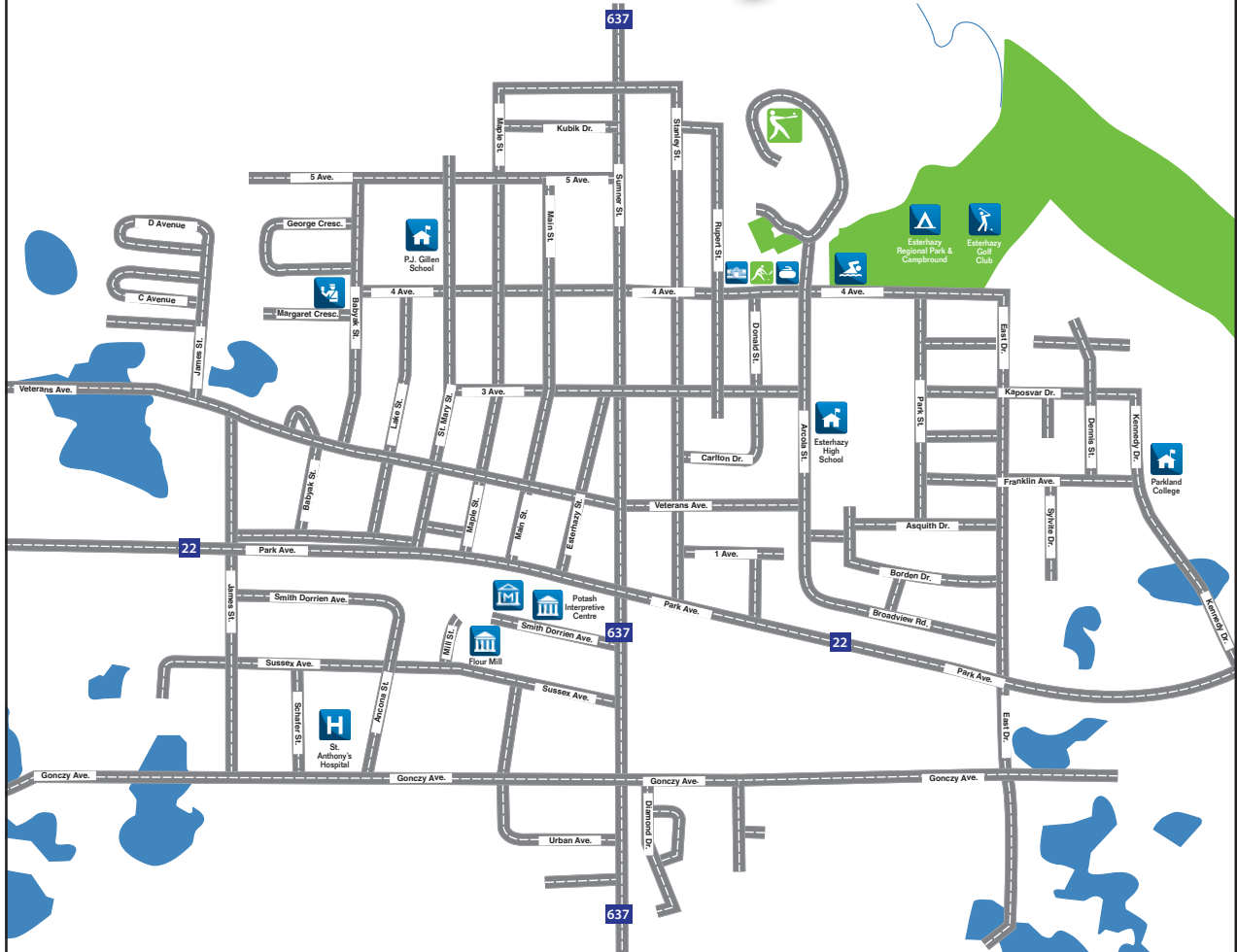
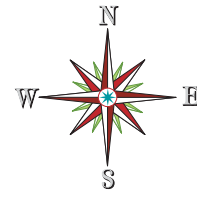

Both the golf course and walking trails run through the valley on the north side of Esterhazy, making them scenic and enjoyable and the campground at the regional park is located right between the pool and the golf course, so it's in the perfect spot to kick back and enjoy the summer!

The town also has a dog park located right along Highway 22 next to the historical park. There are benches to sit on and trees for shade. The park has an area for smaller or timid dogs and an area for dogs that like to play and roughhouse, with separate entrances for both kinds of dogs.

The town has been putting a big focus on beautification lately, especially at their historical park. The park features lots of flowers and trees as well as a beautiful walking trail, and the town has been beautifying its main street as well.

Some of the attractions that Esterhazy offers include:

### ESTERHAZY WALKING TRAIL

The Esterhazy Regional Park took ownership of a trail which was a collection of old roads and bridges and paths cobbled together to form a loop around the Esterhazy Golf Course. The park board decided to try and revive the trail and used the services of a professional trail builder to do so.

### ESTERHAZY FLOUR MILL

This is the only fully equipped flour mill remaining in Saskatchewan that combines an elevator and a mill. Designated as a provincial heritage property in 2005, it also joined the family of national historic sites in 2007 with its designation as a National Historic Site of Canada. A major project to restore the siding took place recently, and the mill looks like new!

### KAPOSVAR HISTORICAL SITE

Kaposvar, one of the first Hungarian settlements in Western Canada, was established in 1886. Kaposvar Historical Society preserves, restores and maintains the Kaposvar Historical Site.

### ESTERHAZY MUSEUM

The museum houses the tourism office for the area and is involved with town promotions. Tours are offered. There are also seasonal and specialty displays to compliment local interest and activities.

### SASKATCHEWAN POTASH INTERPRETIVE CENTRE

The Saskatchewan Potash Interpretive Centre offers visitors an opportunity to learn the unique history of development—how potash is mined and refined, the uses and contribution of this important mineral. # Discover Whitewood this summer!

Located at the crossroads of Highways 1 & 9 in southeastern Saskatchewan, Whitewood is close to Round Lake in the Qu'Appelle Valley (to the north) and Kenosee Lake and Moose Mountain Provincial Park (to the south). Whitewood proudly boasts a modern campground, a swimming pool and a splash park, and a second-to-none nine-hole grass green golf course. The pool structure underwent extensive updates in 2020 and is ready for the new season. A list of attractions in Whitewood includes:

## Larson Park

Larson Park is home to the swimming pool (seasonal), a splash park, newly renovated ball diamonds, modern campground, kiddies' playground, and picnic area. The golf club boasts a challenging (and immensely enjoyable) nine-hole layout well known locally for its high quality greens. Flat and easy to walk, the course has fairways of average width that are bordered by thick growths of trees and affects a player's strategy on the most difficult hole—the par four 9th.

## Walking Trails

The walking trails of Whitewood can be accessed from the Flag Garden on the north end of main street (Lalonde). Get ready for a relaxing little trek alongside the dog park, the golf course and ball diamonds of Whitewood. Also new to Whitewood (2021) are the walking trails located on the south side of Whitewood. Covering an extensive stretch of land, the trail gives residents and visitors alike a more challenging and lengthy trail where hikers/walkers can enjoy the prairies at their best.

## Dog Park

Whitewood now boasts a large free run dog park. Access to the dog park is also at the Flag Garden on main street (north end of Lalonde).

## Millennium Mural

No stop in Whitewood would be complete without seeing our murals, including the Millennium Mural painted on the side of Whitewood Outdoor & Pet Supply store in downtown Whitewood. The mural was created from an original photograph of Whitewood, North West Territories and was painted by local artists. Local artists have also painted large-scale murals on the side of the former Mon Sherry's Haircare building right near the Co-op



grocery store and on the north side of the present Mon Sherry's/Frier's Ag Building right against the gardens adjacent to the Heritage Building.

## Heritage Centre, Archive Building & Historical Library

Whitewood is home to the award-winning Merchant's Bank Heritage Centre in historical downtown Whitewood. The reclaimed building houses an interpretive display featuring the story of the French Counts of St. Hubert. The centre is open by appointment and some Thursday afternoons. The Heritage Building is also home to the Archive and Historical Library, open only by appointment. Contact the Town Office at (306) 735-2210.

## Heritage Walking Tour

What better way to explore Whitewood than at your own pace, assisted by the award-winning Heritage Walking Tour Guide, where you'll see Whitewood's historical buildings. Stop by the Town Office or Whitewood Museum for a copy of the guide.

## Flag Garden

Located at the north end of Lalonde St., the flag garden is comprised of 14 flags standing amidst a beautiful flower garden. The flags represent the ethnic diversity of this area. It's a great place to take a few snapshots, as well as have a picnic.

## Museum/Tourist Booth

Whitewood's Historical Museum also houses the Tourist Information Booth and is located at 603 North Railway. Open from mid-May to early September, it features a rural school and an agriculture building. Visitors will find historical information about the early settlers and artifacts from the people of Whitewood area.

## Old George's

Whitewood is home to Old George's Museum and Hidden Village with its 1900 period home filled with antiques. Old Geo's is located along the Trans-Canada Highway at Whitewood.

## Whitewood Chacachas Rodeo

# Old George's Museum full of treasures

Old George's Museum and Hidden Village is owned by George Chopping and is located on the outskirts of Whitewood, just off Highway 1. It all started in 1984 when Chopping bought an old house that he thought would be perfect for a museum. The house became known as Old George's.

Chopping put a lot of work into making Old George's what it is today. The house, which has 17 rooms and four fireplaces, is also his home. The rooms, from the basement to the attic, are comprised of intricate displays of nearly every antique you can imagine.

"Eighty per cent of the items are from Saskatchewan, 15 per cent are from Manitoba, and five per cent are from Alberta. A few other things are from B.C., the Harbour in Toronto, and other travels I have been on," said Chopping.

His oldest item is a 1636 land title deed from England.

"I have a passion for learning about their history, and sharing that knowledge with people who come here," he said. "I also like to show off what I have. We're all big kids, but not everyone wants to admit that."

Nestled behind

the house, there is also a 'hidden village' comprised of 30 buildings, including a chapel, saloon, blacksmith shop, Chinese laundromat, a clothing store and much more. There is also a stage people can perform on.

Chopping says he has had guests from across North America, as well as overseas.

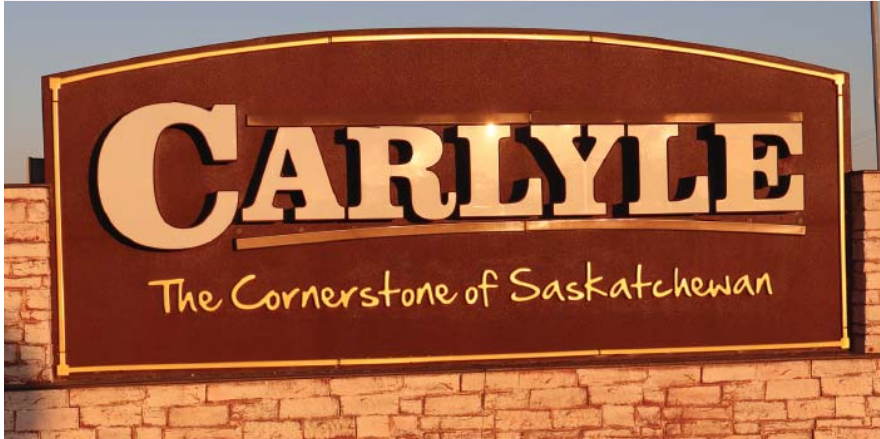

And at the end of the day, there's the Prairie Dog Drive-In just south on Highway 9. As one of the only drive-in theatres left in Saskatchewan, people flock to the Prairie Dog Drive-In on weekends to enjoy a movie in a nostalgic setting on a summer's night, as well as fresh popcorn and treats from the concession at the drive-in.

"I thought you were a Tupperware event," laughed one concert attendee at her very first Kenosee Lake Kitchen Party "KitchenFest" concert in the Moose Mountain Provincial Park in Southeastern Saskatchewan.

The following evening, she returned with a carload of her friends. And the very next August, she registered herself and her grandson to learn to play the guitar, camping in her RV and diving in to everything to fully experience what the music camp offers.

Have you ever wondered why we call it "A Kitchen Party?" Or what happens at a music camp where all ages and abilities are included? Because the Kenosee Lake Kitchen Party (or KLKP for short) is not your typical summer Band Camp.

To be fair, KLKP does have some elements in common with a summer camp.

We partner with the Kenosee Boys and Girls camp using their wonderful facility. At KLKP, everyone mixes no matter age, background or musical ability. From the raw beginner who is just starting out on the guitar/fiddle/banjo to the seasoned performer attending for the creative boost that comes from being immersed in music for a full five days, all musicians of all ages congregate and support each other.

The KLKP culture quickly becomes apparent: a love of the musical community, an acceptance and inclusion of everyone who arrives, an ability to laugh and frolic and eat and talk and play games and enjoy each other's company. It's a place where everyone matters, where children mingle with the adults and are mentored and protected by the whole community. Where, after the children are tucked in, the adults continue to enjoy great conversations, meaningful exchanges of music, fellowship and fun. It's a place where we truly speak each other's language, and respect the places from which each has arrived.

KLKP is a family friendly Kitchen Party where friendship, music, food, dancing and shenanigans combine into five days of pure musical joy. We aim to model healthy lifestyles for children and families and show them that a wonderful time can be experienced without requiring substance use or abuse. Every year we are happy to gather with friends, old and new, and dive back into the joy of community. At KLKP, we can't wait. Our 2024 camps will be from August 5-8 and August 12-15.

In 2024, because of exceptional support and funding from generous sponsors, KLKP will not turn any child away because of an inability to pay the full fee! Our goal is inclusion; our hope is that every child has the chance to soar and play music if they'd like to.

## Kipling worth exploring this summer!

Driving by, Kipling may appear to be just another small town in Saskatchewan. However, if you take the time to tour around you will see that it has many of the amenities that you would find in a larger center, but with the small-town advantage!

During the summer months, residents enjoy watching ball games, going for a dip in the pool that is located next to the campgrounds, a soak in the hot tub after a workout at the local gym, or an afternoon of golf at the town's nine-hole grass green course.

Afterwards, take a stroll on the town's Heritage Walking Tour or visit the museum grounds and take a short trip out to view the century-old fully restored Bekevar Church.

The twin-spired church in Debrecen, Hungary, influenced the design of the Bekevar Presbyterian Church, located eight miles southeast of Kipling. The church was the cultural center of the Hungarian community for many years. The church is still used for special occasions. Guided tours are available throughout the summer months.

## Take a drive back in time

The Elkhorn Auto Museum, located just off Highway 1 in Elkhorn, Manitoba is a good place to stop for a quick drive into history.

The museum has been running each summer since 1967. Most of the automobile collection was donated by Isaac Clarkson, who passed away in 1971 at the age of 58.

There are over 90 vehicles on display, ranging from a 1908 Reo to a 1976 Jaguar. Automobiles aren't the only items to see at the museum. There is also an old farm house from the early 1900s that has been restored by the museum committee and moved onto the museum grounds, as well as a historic church, and an old school building at the museum where people can view old maps, desks, and posters.

One of the biggest events held at the museum each year is the Elkhorn Museum Day on July 1. The day usually includes a parade, a threshing demonstration, demonstrations of pioneer life, and many activities at the museum grounds.

The Automobile Museum is wheelchair accessible and even provides wheelchairs for people to wheel around the displays.

The museum is open seven days a week from 10 am to 6 pm until the end of September. Admission is \$10 for adults and \$2 for students. Preschoolers are free.

# History of St. Lazare & RM of Ellice



St Lazare got its beginning as a Roman Catholic mission in the 1820's. It was founded by Oblate Father Jules DeCorby, who had immigrated from France in 1867.

Father DeCorby was at this time attached to the mission at Lebret, Saskatchewan. Father DeCorby named this new mission St Lazare to commemorate the place in France from which he departed on his journey to Canada.

The mission was located at the junction of the Qu'Appelle and the Assiniboine Rivers, approximately 3 miles north of the Hudson Bay Company's Fort Ellice. Church services in those early years were held in the homes of these early settlers, which were mostly Métis families. Since Father DeCorby was very nomadic, traveling from mission to mission, other missionaries from Lebret helped with the St Lazare mission, namely Fathers St. Germain, Campeau and Lepage.

In 1880, a log Church was built and Father DeCorby became the first resident priest. At about this time, a French Canadian, Delphis Chartier and family, arrived at Fort Ellice via steamboat and settled at the mission. He eventually opened a post office, October 1st, 1895, and various other businesses. In 1895, Father DeCorby was replaced by Father Léon Favreau and in 1898 a new stone Church was constructed under the supervision of Mr. Chartier. The new Church was blessed by the Archbishop of St Boniface Adelard Langevin, in 1899. A stone rectory was also built at this time.

In 1900, Father Favreau conducted a census of the mission. The census which included men, women and children was 89 families, 456 souls in all broken down as follows. Métis 342, French Canadians 34, French 15, Irish 30, Scotch 19 and Germans 18. On May 13, 1909, the mission of St Lazare was declared a parish by

the Archbishop of St Boniface Adelard Langevin.

On July 7, 1883, the Rural Municipality of Ellice was born, with its headquarters at Fort Ellice. With the decline of the fort and the emergence of St Lazare, its permanent headquarters were moved to St Lazare with the first meeting in the space rented from Father Favreau on January 6th, 1902. In 1905, the merchants of the mission anticipated the coming of the railway and began relocating to what is the present day location of the Village of St Lazare. Records indicate the railroad opened in 1908.

Many businesses sprung up at this new site, general stores, barber shop, pool room, blacksmith shop, hotel. Eugene Fouillard started a Massey Ferguson dealership. In 1911, a grain elevator owned and operated by the Atlas Grain Company opened its doors.

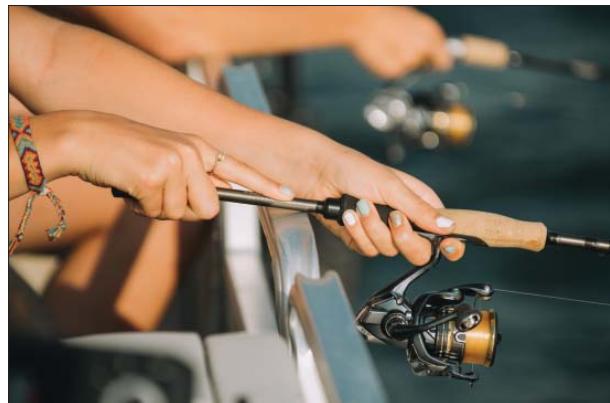

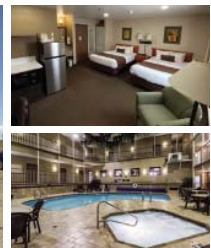

Moosomin is also the home of a newly formed women's fastball team that will be playing at Bradley Park again this year—the Ladies Predators!

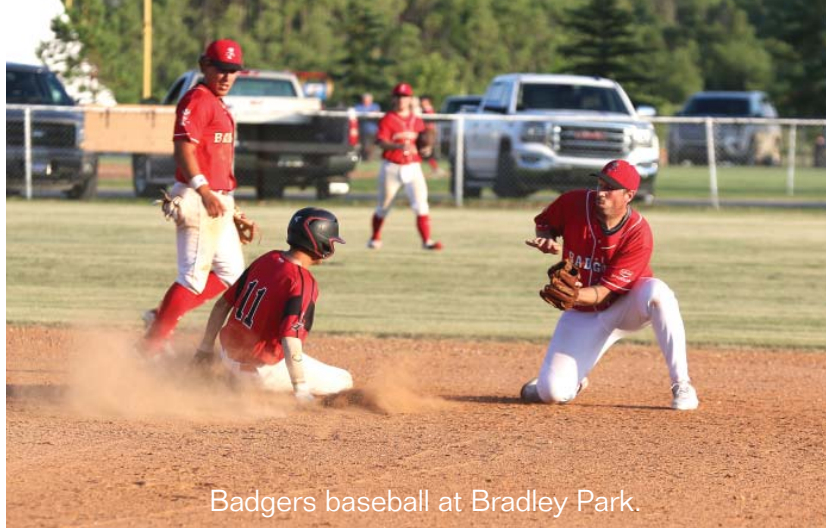
The town also has a huge number of kids registered in Minor Soccer, Minor Ball, and Generals, making for hundreds of kids playing at the park through the spring!

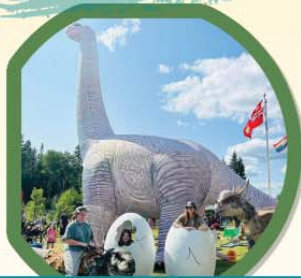

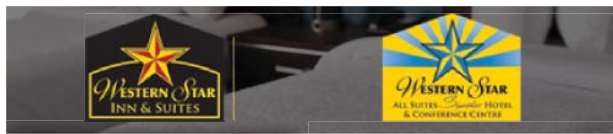
